## Notice Concerning Acquisition of Science Based Targets (SBT) certification

Medical Data Vision Co., Ltd. today announced that it has achieved Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi)  $\%^1$  certification for its Near-Term Target  $\%^2$  for reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. These targets are aligned with the goals of the Paris Agreement  $\%^3$  to limit global warming to 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels.



## DRIVING AMBITIOUS CORPORATE CLIMATE ACTION

Contents of the Approved Near-Term Targets by SBTi

Scope 1 + 2: Reduce GHG emissions by 42% compared to FY2023 levels by FY2030.

Scope 3: Reduce GHG emissions by 25% compared to FY2023 levels by FY2030.

We have identified contributing to a decarbonized society as one of our material issues. We recognize the following two major risks associated with climate change scenarios.

The first risk is a decline in demand due to the lack of environmentally friendly services. The second risk is an increase in funding and recruitment costs due to insufficient GHG emissions reductions and inadequate disclosure of climate-related information.

To contribute to a decarbonized society, we will prioritize the use of environmentally friendly data centers and transition our electricity consumption to renewable energy sources.

\*\* An organization that certifies whether a company's GHG emissions reduction targets (SBT: Science Based Targets) are aligned with the GHG emissions reduction targets set by the Paris Agreement, based on the latest climate science.

 $%^2$  The targets certified by the SBTi are classified into two types: Near-Term (targets for 5 to 10 years ahead, with a minimum required reduction of 4.2% per year) and Long-Term (targets up to 2050, with a minimum required reduction of 90%). Our company has received certification for a Near-Term Target.

¾³ A global commitment to keep the rise in global temperatures well below 2°C above pre-industrial levels, while striving to limit the increase to 1.5°C.
